- 1- William Ellis Green ,aged 82 ,was making his breakfast when he heard somebody in the garden .' The bulglar tried to cycle away ,but the tyres on the bike were flat so it was difficult to ride. 'He kept falling off the bicycle', said Mr Green, 'at least three or four times'. After the man had fled, Mr Green called the local police.
- 2- When they arrived ,officers asked him to describe the man, but instead he offered to draw them a picture.
