Can (to be able to)	ability, doubt, astonishment permission, polite request	You can do it You could do it	He can't be 15. He looks much older
May (to be allowed to)	permission, if not prohibition, supposition with doubt	We may go We might go	
Must	obligation, firm necessity, logical conclusion, probability	We must do it He must be ill	
Shall	intention, supposition	I shall do it He shall arrive home by Monday	
Will	wish, desire, will, confidence in the future	I will go there I would go there	
Ought to	moral duty, insistent advice, strict recommendation	You ought to write this letter	
Need	(un)necessity	Need he work so late? We need not have hurried	
Dare	impertinence	How dare you speak to me? He dare not tell it to me	
Used to	repeated action in the past	He used to live in London	
Should	necessity, advice, blame, recommendation, reproach, regret	He should not smoke so much. You should not cut your hair	
Would	wish (with "to like"), polite request, a habit of the past	Would you like to come again? Would you mind?	
Have to	unwillingness, forced circumstances	I have to do it I had to do it yesterday I'll have to do it tomorrow	
Be to	obligation arising out of arrangement or agreement	I am to read it I was to read it I shall be to read it
